The score is arranged in a standard orchestral format with vocal parts. The instruments and their parts are:

- Flute I & II:** Both parts play a melodic line starting with a forte (*sf*) dynamic, then moving to piano (*p*). Flute II has a *Flute* marking above the staff.
- Oboe:** Plays a melodic line with *sf* and *p* dynamics.
- Clarinet I & II:** Plays a harmonic line with *sf* and *p* dynamics. Includes the marking "In B $\flat$ ".
- Bassoon:** Plays a harmonic line with *sf* and *p* dynamics.
- Horn I & II in F:** Plays a harmonic line with *sf* and *p* dynamics.
- Yum-Yum:** Vocal part with lyrics: "Were I not to Ko - Ko plight - ed, I would say in ten-der tone, "Loved one, let us be u-".
- Nanki-Poo:** Vocal part, mostly silent in this section.
- Violin I & II:** Play a rhythmic accompaniment of eighth notes with a *p* dynamic.
- Viola:** Plays a harmonic line with a *p* dynamic.
- Violoncello:** Plays a harmonic line with a *p* dynamic.
- Contrabass:** Plays a harmonic line with a *p* dynamic.
